DIRECTOR GENERAL (01)

(Sri Lanka Institute of Development Administration - SLIDA)

Applications are called from the qualified officers for the above post in Sri Lanka Institute of Development Administration (SLIDA).

Qualifications and Competencies:

- ❖ Shall be an officer in the Special Grade of Sri Lanka Administrative Service with a postgraduate degree in a field related to the scope of Sri Lanka Institute of Development Administration and have completed a service period of 20 years, in executive / management post in which five (05) years should be in the Senior Management Level.
or,
- ❖ Shall have obtained a postgraduate degree in a field related to the scope of Sri Lanka Institute of Development Administration, recognized by the University Grants Commission
and
- ❖ Shall have experience of 20 years as an officer in the Senior Executive Management level at Sri Lanka Institute of Development Administration in which three (03) years should be in a post of Additional Director General.
or
- ❖ Shall have completed a service period of 20 years in posts in executive/management level at the government or a statutory board, in which five (05) years' experience should be in Senior Management (HM 2-1) level with a postgraduate degree in a field related to the scope of Sri Lanka Institute of Development Administration, recognized by the University Grants Commission.
- ❖ Shall not be less than 35 years and not more than 55 years of age. No maximum age limit is applied to internal applicants and government employees.
- ❖ The application along with the bio-data should be sent to reach Secretary, Ministry of Public Services, Provincial Councils and Local Government, Independence Square, Colombo 07 on or before 09th of February 2021.
