RECRUITMENT OF GRADUATES AND DIPLOMATES TO THE SRI LANKA TEACHERS SERVICE FOR THE TEACHER VACANCIES THAT EXIST IN SCHOOLS IN THE NORTH CENTRAL PROVINCE - 2021

(Sinhala / Tamil / Dual Language)

Applications are invited from qualified males and females for recruitment on Education Zonal level of graduates to Class 3 Grade 1 (a) of the Sri Lanka Teacher Service and Diploma Holders to Class 3 Grade 1 (c) of the Sri Lanka Teacher Service for the teacher vacancies that exist in the schools in the North Central Province. Applications will be closed on 31.08.2021.

01. Eligibility
- 1.1 General Qualifications
- i. Should be a citizen of Sri Lanka.

ii. Should have an excellent moral character and physically fit.

iii. Should be not less than 18 years and not more than 35 years as at 31.08.2021.

iv. Should have completed the degree / diploma and all educational qualifications on or before 31.08.2021.

v. Should have been a permanent resident of the North Central Province for not less than three (03) years preceding 31.08.2021. If adequate number of applicants with qualification for Science, Special Education, Mathematics, Second Language (Tamil), Agri and Food Technology, Art, Information and Communication Technology, Home Economy Advanced Level subjects cannot be selected from the North Central Province, Applicants island-wide will be considered subject to serving in the North Central Province for a minimum of 10 years. Permanent residency should be proved either by the Electoral List or by a Certificate issued by the Grama Niladhari.

- 13 Institutions and universities offering the degrees to prove the educational qualifications should have been approved by the University Grants Commission.
- 14 If a general degree is obtained with the subject applying as the first qualification for the subjects applying for, that subject should have been passed as a main subject of the degree and 1/3 of the number of credits in the degree course should have been completed relevant to the subject applying for.
- 15 In addition to the above qualifications, applicants should have passed in six (06) subjects with minimum three (03) credit passes with passes in Mother Tongue and Mathematics in not more than two sittings at the G.C.E. (Ordinary Level) Examination and passed in three (03) subjects in one sitting at the G.C.E. (Ordinary Level) Examination before the date of passing the degree or diploma.
- 16 A pass at the G.C.E. (Ordinary Level) examination relevant to the language medium in the schools where the vacancy for the Second Language exists.
- 17 All the above mentioned qualifications should have been fulfilled as at the closing date of applications or before in every manner.
2. Method of Recruitment and Service Conditions
- Applicants should obtain minimum 40% of the marks for each subject to pass the competitive examination conducted either by the Commissioner General of Examinations or the Public Service Commission of the North Central Province. Total marks obtained by the applicants for the subjects for which applications have been invited and considering the total preference given in paragraph 4.3 applicants will be subjected to a non-structured interview as per the order of merit obtained on Zonal Education level. Those who pass the general interview will be subjected to a practical test and the suitable persons will be selected. If the order of merit an applicant has obtained is inadequate for selection for the vacancies that exist in the Educational Zones applying for, should agree to serve in any zone within the North Central Province.
- 2.1 Teachers recruited under the 13 year Certified Education subject field should teach only in the same subject field.
- 2.2 If the number of applicants who have applied is less than the number of vacancies that exist for a subject for which applications have been called, suitable persons will be selected through a general interview and a trade test.
- 2.3 If the selections are made preference will be given to unemployed graduates. Applicants selected should agree to serve in any school within the North Central Province to be placed in the vacancies that exist.
- 2.4 Written Examination: Written examination will be conducted in Sinhala, Tamil and English mediums either by the Commissioner General of Examinations or by the North Central Provincial Public Service Commission. Applications should be performed in the medium of the applicants wish to sit the exam. Permission will not be granted to change the medium of sitting the exam after the applications are submitted.
- a). This written examination will consist of two question papers.
I. Aptitude Test - 01 Hour Duration (100 Marks)
II. General Knowledge - 01 Hour Duration (100 Marks)
- b). Syllabus
Subject No. 1 – Aptitude test
This question paper will be prepared to test the skills and the logical strength the candidates possess in the teaching profession. This question paper will consist of 50 multiple and short answer style questions.
Subject No. 2 – General Knowledge
This question paper will consist of multiple and short answer style questions to test the general knowledge in the teaching field and relevant to the field and / or general knowledge regarding the educational trends that have taken place and are taking place locally and the general knowledge in modernization of education.
- 2.5 General Interview
This interview will be conducted to check whether the applicant has fulfilled the qualifications mentioned in this notice for recruitment to the teacher service and to test the physical and mental fitness of the candidate. Only the basic qualifications will be checked at the normal interview and no marks will be given.
- 2.6 Practical Test
Practical test will be conducted to test the skills the applicant possesses regarding the teaching process which is important to the teaching profession. Applicant will have to make a presentation of not less than five (05) minutes under a subject identified by the applicant. For the practical test 25 marks will be given. No marks will be given to any Power Point Presentation. Marks will be given as follows:

- 2.7 This post is permanent and pensionable. Appointee will be subject to any policy decision taken by the government in the future regarding the pension entitled to the post.
- 2.8 Salary
Monthly salary scale under Salary Category GE-1 - 2016 entitled to this appointment as per Public Administration Circular No. 3/2016 dated 23.02.2016 will be Rs. 27,740 - 300,066 - 380,777 - 445,327 - Rs. 33,090/-. Graduates will be placed in Salary Step 14 and the Diploma Holders will be placed in Salary Step 7 of the monthly salary scale. In addition to the above they will be entitled to other allowances paid to government officers by the government from time to time.
- 2.9 Qualified selected candidates will be to be general conditions that govern the government appointments, conditions laid down in the North Central Provincial Teacher Service Minutes and to the Amendments made already to the said Minutes and to the amendments to be made in the future.
- 2.10 Promotions to the Teacher Service will be made under the provisions of the North Central Provincial Teacher Service Minutes.

4. Method of Applying
- 4.1 Applications should be self prepared by the applicants as per the specimen given below in the advertisement using both sides of A4 size paper and the applications should be performed by applicant's own handwriting. Please note that the Headings 1 - 5 should appear in the Front Page and 6 - 8 should appear in the rear page while the rest should appear in the third page.
- 4.2 Applications of the applicants who have not fulfilled the qualifications in every manner and the applications not in conformity with the specimen application, incomplete and applications for which examination fee has not been paid and the late applications will be rejected. Suitable persons will not be allowed to sit the examination. It will be intimated. (Retaining a photocopy of the application by the applicant may be useful.)
- 4.3 Applicant should mention in the application three (03) education zones along with the Zonal Nos. in the order of his choice where the vacancies exist for the subjects applying for. (Please refer Annexure I for the list of vacancies).

- 4.4 In the Applications submitted by persons with special requirements, nature of impairment should be marked in red in the left hand top corner of the application.
- 4.5 One candidate can send only one application for one subject. Permission will not be granted to change the subject later. Separate applications should be submitted if applying for more than one subject and the examination fee should be paid separately.
- 4.6 Officers employed in the government and Provincial public service should definitely direct their applications through the heads of their respective institutions and the certification should be obtained that the Head of the Institution agrees to release the applicant from the institution if selected.
- 4.7 Examination fee is Rs. 600/-. This amount may be paid to any District / Divisional Secretariat within the North Central Province to be credited to the Revenue Unit, bearing No. 2002.02.02, of the North Central Provincial Council. The receipt NC 100 issued upon payment should be affixed firmly in the specified case in the application. Examination fees will not be refunded under any circumstance and the transfer of the examination fee to any other examination will not be permitted. Further, Money orders and Stamps will not be accepted. Applications for which the examination fee has not been paid will be rejected. (Retaining a photocopy of the receipt may be beneficial). Receipts obtained from any other Divisional Secretariats other than the Divisional Secretariats within the North Central Province or banks or Post Offices and applications with such receipts and receipts of late payment will be rejected.
- 4.8 Signature of the applicant in the application should have been attested either by a principal of a government school, Justice of the Peace, Commissioner of District, Attorney at Law, Notary Public, Commissioned Officer of the Sri Lankan Police, or a gazetted Officer of Sri Lanka Police or by a government Staff Officer holding a permanent post.
- 4.9 Duly performed applications should be sent by registered post addressed to "Secretary, Provincial Public Service Commission, District Secretariat Premises, Amradhapura" to receive on or before 31.08.2021. It is mandatory to mention (Recruitment of Graduates / Diploma Holders to the Sri Lanka Teacher Service - 2021) and the Applying District and Subject and the District of Permanent Residency should be mandatorily mentioned on the left hand top corner of the envelope containing the application.
- 4.10 Any complaints regarding any loss or delay in post will not be entertained.
- 4.11 If there are any discrepancies among the Sinhala, Tamil and English advertisements that are being published, Sinhala medium advertisement will be deemed as correct and final and will be taken accordingly.
