- > Carrying out SMS/internal audit, both shore based and onboard of all CSC Ships in consultation with Head of Technical Department.
- Monitors ships operations by frequent inspection of various ship records >
- > To ensure monitoring and upgrading of the Safety Management System (SMS)on board and following-up with shipboard recordings.
- Order and carry out all the statutory and classification society surveys in time.
- Ensuring that adequate resources and shore-based support are supplied and procurement for repairs and > spare parts.
- Continuous monitoring, especially remote monitoring for the DPA evaluation and review of the effectiveness of the SMS
- Investigating, Reporting and analysis of non-conformities of Ship's Crew, accidents and hazardous occurrences.
