The work schedule for this position is: Full Time - 40 hours per week The monthly gross salary for this position will be Rs. 92,826/-

Qualifications Required:

1. Education -

Completion of Secondary education (Completion of G.C.E. Ordinary Level - Candidate must have passed six subjects including Mathematics and possess Distinctions or Credits for at least three subjects) and/or completion of vocational training from an accredited institute recognized as producing journeyman-level technicians with a concentration in electrical principles and applications is required. (Must attach copies of relevant educational certificate/s).

2. Prior Work Experience -

A minimum of three (3) years of experience in the repair and maintenance of electrical systems, equipment, and components is required. (Must attach copies of relevant service/work experience certificates).

3. Language Proficiency -

English level II (Limited knowledge) Reading/Writing/Speaking is required. (*This will be tested*).

Sinhala level III (Good working knowledge) Reading/Writing/Speaking is required.

4. Skills & Abilities -

A valid class "B" driver's license (formerly C, C1) with a clean driving record is required. (A copy of the driving license should be attached) (Safe driving skills may be tested).
