- Commercialize mature technologies developed by the staff and students e.g. start-ups, spin offs and industry adaptations
- Conduct training programs for the industry and the general public
- Facilitate to carry out consultancies such as Environmental Impact Assessment Studies, Feasibility Studies, Design Project and Corporate Plan and Energy Audits.
- Organize international collaborative training programmes
- Conduct research and social studies, data analysis based on national interests
- Materials testing, Product assessment and evaluations
- Third party independent audits based on Customer's protocol
- Field-based surveys and studies
- Facilitate conference and guest seminar or lecturer presentations
- · Industry Sponsorship
- Seek and obtain grants from bodies such as the UGC, NSF,NRC,SLIC etc.
- Set up an accelerator with support from relevant industries to create start-ups based on an equity share or royalty fee.

Conditions:

- 1. The appointment will be made for a period of three years.
- The Director will be the chief coordinating and administrative officer for the activities of the OUSL-ILC.
- The appointee shall be paid an allowance determined by the Council.
