The grant will offer a maximum salary of Rs 55,000.00 per month all-inclusive subject to EPF and ETF payment as per the labor law of Sri Lanka.

### **Job Profile**

Research Assistant shall be required to discharge duties as per Terms of Reference of the position specially designing questionnaires for key informant interviews, communicating with relevant government bodies such as Sri Lanka Bureau of Foreign Employment, Sri Lanka Police Department, District, and local authorities, conducting key informant interviews, organizing awareness programs, and engaging in related fieldwork require traveling.
