VACANCIES

Applications will be received up to **28.04.2023** from suitably qualified persons for the following posts. Applications should be made on the prescribed form obtainable from the Postgraduate Institute of English.

Post of Senior Lecturer Grade I/ Senior Lecturer Grade II/ Lecturer (Unconfirmed)/Lecturer (Probationary) in English (01 post)

(Preference will be given to applicants with PhDs and teaching and research experience in the following areas: Applied Linguistics; Sociolinguistics; Teaching English as a Second Language and related areas; English for Academic Purposes; and knowledge of research writing and research methodology in the social sciences and humanities. Applicants with experience in postgraduate level teaching, coordination, curriculum development, and materials design will be considered). Candidates with exposure to diverse multicultural pedagogical contexts, and who are familiar with international pedagogical practices and systems are asked to highlight this aspect of their experience.

(A) Senior Lecturer Grade I - Rs. 91,310 - 7 x 2,170 - 106,500 p.m. [U-AC 3 (I)]

(B) Senior Lecturer Grade II - Rs. 79,360 - 11 x 1,630 - 97,290 p.m. [U-AC 3 (II)]

(C) Lecturer (Unconfirmed) - Rs. 69,580 - 5 x 1,630 - 77,730 p.m. [U-AC 3 (III)]

(D) Lecturer (Probationary) - Rs. 54,600 - 10 x 1,335 - 67,950 p.m. [U-AC 3 (IV)]

BENEFITS

All permanent appointees will become contributors to the Universities Provident Fund, contributing 10% of their monthly earnings and the University contributing an amount equivalent to 7%. In addition, they will become contributors to the Employees' Trust Fund and the University Pension Scheme to which the University will contribute 3% and 8% of the monthly earnings of the employee respectively. The holders of the above posts are eligible to receive a research allowance of 35% of their basic salary in addition to the above.

SABBATICAL LEAVE:

The holders of the Post of Senior Lecturer Gr. II and above are eligible for one year of sabbatical leave with pay or two years without pay on completion of seven years of service. Those proceeding abroad on sabbatical leave are eligible to receive full passage* for self and spouse. (*currently suspended)

Applicants from University System /Government Departments/ Corporations/ Statutory Boards should channel their applications through the Heads of their respective Institutions. The PGIE reserves the right to shortlist the candidates. Applications which do not conform to the requirements, incomplete applications, illegible applications, and applications not in the relevant format (not obtained from the PGIE) and applications received after the closing date will be rejected without intimation.
