## **Pharmacist**





## Description

- Dispense medication to the patients.
- Request drugs from the main drug stores.
- · Assesses the optimal level of stock that needs to be held at the pharmacy in accordance with the daily requirements of the pharmacy.
- Takes responsibility for the accuracy of the drugs issued and dispensed.
- Ensures confidentiality of patient information.
- · Reviews prescriptions issued by the Physician, or other authorized prescriber to assure accuracy and appropriateness of medication.
- Answers questions and provides information to customers on drug interactions, side effects, dosage and storage of pharmaceuticals.
- Maintains established procedures concerning quality assurance, security of controlled substances, and disposal of drugs designated as hazardous waste.
- Evaluates medications to determine identity, purity, and strength.
- Instructs interns and other medical personnel on matters pertaining to the pharmacy.
- Comply with all National Laws and Regulations as stated by NMRA.
- Monitor effectiveness of newly added medication.
- Investigate the ADR and take corrective and preventive action.
- Ensuring that drugs are received and stored in an appropriate manner in accordance with the manufacturers' instructions and hospital policy.
- Ensuring that refrigerated items are stored at the appropriate temperature and maintaining the temperature control record/logbook.
- Work as part of a multidisciplinary team to provide high Quality patient care.
- Identifies ways to improve care of patients, and make recommendations to the DMS.
- Participates in quality improvement of the program in conjunction with other services offered.
- Performs any other function delegated by superior
