Key responsibilities will include:

- Use in-depth consulting skills, business knowledge, and expertise to effectively integrate Application Security features into client business environment in order to achieve end user expectations by developing and implementing reliable, measurable, consistent and responsive security settings on application development process to ensure business continuity as per the Information Security Management framework in SriLankan IT Systems.
- Continuously monitor and review existing and upcoming web applications, web services, and internet facing applications for website vulnerabilities including, but not limited to Cross Site Scripting, Injection Flaws, Malicious Files Execution, Insecure Direct Object Reference etc. and provide expertise and guidance in consent with Requirement Study Team, Application Development Team and Application Deployment Team to influence an effective, secure environment.
- Proactively detect and mitigate internal and external security threats to applications by continuously monitoring the behavior patterns through system events/logs and build and maintain effective firewall configurations while developing user friendly reports and alerts to ensure the effectiveness of the controls.
