

ANNEXURE II

Guidelines to evaluate Publications :

I. Publications :

(a) Journal Papers – An academically important essay or article with a full copy which was reviewed and published in a series of a numbered publication.

(b) Conference Papers/ abstracts/ final essays.

Reports, which were circulated at academically important conferences, congresses, seminars, colloquiums, forums, workshops or symposiums.

II. In the case of publications with joint authorship, applicant's proportionate should be indicated and their actual contribution to the work published should be established and marks should be allocated accordingly.

III. Publications which are based on same data/ research material where the contents of the publications have a high similarity index will not be considered as separate publications. Only one of the publications shall be eligible to earn marks.
