ANNEXURE II

Guidelines to evaluate Publications:

- I. Publications:
- (a) Journal Papers An academically important essay or article with a full copy which was reviewed and published in a series of a numbered publication.
- (b) Conference Papers/ abstracts/ final essays.
 - Reports, which were circulated at academically important conferences, congresses, seminars, colloquiums, forums, workshops or symposiums.
- II. In the case of publications with joint authorship, applicant's proportionate should be indicated and their actual contribution to the work published should be established and marks should be allocated accordingly.
- III. Publications which are based on same data/ research material where the contents of the publications have a high similarity index will not be considered as separate publications. Only one of the publications shall be eligible to earn marks.
