Qualifications for Academic Posts

01. Lecturer (Probationary)

(1) A Degree with specialization in the relevant subject with First or Second Class (Upper Division) Honours and at least 01 year experience in teaching/research/professional work/postgraduate studies.

OR

(2) A Degree with specialization in the relevant subject with Second Class (Lower Division) Honours and at least 01 year experience in teaching/ research/ professional work/ postgraduate studies

OR

(3) (a) A degree with specialization in the relevant subject-without Honours or any other degree with at least Second Class Honours, and (b) A Postgraduate Degree of at least 02 academic years duration in the relevant subject with a research component by way of thesis/dissertation;

OR

(4) Such academic or professional qualifications or professional experience as may be approved by the University Grants Commission upon the recommendation of the Higher Educational Institution concerned.

02. Senior Lecturer, Grade II

(1) Candidates shall possess the academic qualifications required for Lecturer (Probationary).

AND

(2) (i) A Master's Degree in the relevant field obtained after a full-time course of study of at least two academic years (or an equivalent part-time course of study) with a research component by way of thesis/dissertation or a Doctoral Degree.

In the case of Faculties of Arts, Humanities, a Master's Degree of one year's duration in the relevant field may be accepted when combined with an evaluated research record in conformity with current guidelines.

OR

(ii) Such professional qualifications and experience as may be approved by the University Grants Commission upon the recommendation of the Higher Educational Institution concerned.

AND

- (3) At least six (06) years experience in one or more of the following:-
 - (i) Teaching at University Level,
 - (ii) Professional experience,
 - (iii) Research in a recognized Institution,
 - (iv) Postgraduate Studies to acquire the qualifications stipulated at (2) above.
- (d) The current guidelines in regard to evaluated research and dissemination is that a candidate should obtain a minimum total of 15 marks and the marking scheme for this purpose is section 2.0 and 3.1 of the marking scheme for post of association professor/professor.

03. Lecturer (Temporary)

(1) A Bachelor's Honors/Special Degree with specialization in the relevant subject with First or Second Class (Upper Division)

OR

- (2) A Bachelor's Honours/Special Degree with specialization in the relevant subject with Second Class (Lower Division)
- (3) (a) A Degree with specialization in the relevant subject without Honours or any other degree with at least Second Class Honours,

And

(b) A recognized postgraduate degree in the relevant subject.

Note:

- * As per the University Grants Commissions Circular 17/2005, candidates may be considered for appointment to the post of Senior Lecturer (Grade II/I) based on their qualifications.
- * Lecturer (probationary)/Lecturer (unconfirmed)/Senior Lecturer, II/I, the appointees to the above posts should sign a bond with the university, agreeing to work continuously for five years from the date of the first appointment.

2. Should have passed all the three subjects at the G.C.E.(A/L) Examination (Except the Common General Paper) at one sitting, of which one subject should be **Accounting**.

Preference will be given to those who possess the following qualifications;

a). An acceptable qualification in Computer Applications of not less than six (06) months duration obtained from a recognized institute.

b). Two years of experience in the use of Computer Application Packages.

- II. Should be not less than 18 years and not more than 30 years of age on the closing date of applications.
