The ICT Assistant would be responsible for providing key MIS support for Programme Officers and stakeholders. S/he would involve in Database Management, website maintenance and designing of Programme Promotional materials.

Qualifications/Experience Required:

 Diploma in Information Technology from a recognized institution with minimum of 02 years post qualifying IT based experience.

OR

Certificate of proficiency not below than NVQ level 7 in Information Communication Technology with minimum of five (05) years post qualifying IT based experience in a reputed establishment.

University Degree (Bachelor's Degree) in Computer Science, Information Technology, Information Management would be an asset.

Hands-on Experience in designing applications, Photoshops, In-designing, Web designing etc. and ability to maintain Database Management System (DBMS), Monitoring and Information System (MIS) and LAN/NAN will be added qualifications.

2 to 3 years' experience in networking and communication, MIS helpdesk is required. Experience in working with secured information system is preferable.
