A. 1. POST OF ASSISTANT NETWORK MANAGER, GRADE - II (01 Vacancy)

Qualifications for recruitment:

I. A first class or second class in the B.Sc. special degree in Computer Science/ Computer Engineering from a recognized University.

OR

II. (a) A pass in the B. Sc. Special degree in Computer Science/ Computer Engineering from a recognized University.

OR

A first class or second class in the B. Sc. General Degree with Computing as a subject component from a recognized University

AND

(b) One year experience in the field of Computing/ Networking.

OR

III. (a) A pass in the B.Sc. General Degree with Computing as a subject component from a recognized University

OR

A first class or second class in the B. Sc. General Degree (Where Computing is not a subject component) from a recognized University.

AND

(b) Two years' experience in the field of Computing/Networking

OR

IV. A pass in the B. Sc. General Degree (Where Computing is not a subject component) from a recognized University.

AND

Three years' experience in the field of Computing/ Networking

OR

V. Any other Degree

A Postgraduate Diploma in Computer Science/Computer Technology from a recognized University.

AND

One year's experience as a Computer Programmer in the University Service.

VI. 15 years' experience as a Computer Programmer in the University Service.

 - iii. Mathematics

2. Should have passed in all subjects at G.C.E. (A/L) Examination (except the Common General Paper) at one sitting (Passing in 3 subjects under the old syllabus at one sitting would be sufficient for this purpose)

AND

- 3. Preference/priority will be given to those who possess the following.
 - (a) Studentship or Part/full qualification in Library and Information Science obtained from a recognized institute.

AND

(b) An acceptable qualification in Computer applications of not less than six (06) months duration obtained from a recognized institute.

B. <u>Common Criteria for Recruitment of Assistant Network Manager (Gr.II), Management Assistant Gr, III and Library Information Assistant Gr. III</u>

- 1. General Qualifications for recruitment:
 - 1. Be a citizen of Sri Lanka
 - 2. Should be not less than 18 years and not more than 30 years of age (This age limit is not applicable for Assistant Network Manager (Gr. II)) on the closing date of applications
 - 3. Be a person of an excellent moral character
 - 4. Sound knowledge and capacity of communicating in English.
- 2. Government approved allowances will be paid and contributions to Universities Provident Fund (UPF), Universities Pension Scheme and Employees' Trust Fund (ETF) will also applicable.

C. Method of Recruitment:

- I. By Written Examination of following subjects (70%)
 - Knowledge in Sinhala/Tamil & English Language
 - Intelligent quotient and General Knowledge
 - Computer Literacy

Candidates should secure minimum 40% marks in each subject to pass written examination and minimum of 40 % marks to face the interview.

AND

II. Interview

Candidates should secure a minimum of 40% marks to pass the interview

If selected through a written examination and interview, final selection will be in the order of merit based on the aggregate of 75% of the marks at the written examination and 25% of the marks at the interview.
