- 01. These posts are permanent. The appointments will be on probation for a period of three (03) years.
- 02. Selected candidates if presently serving in a Government Department will have to obtain his/ her release through their respective appointing authority.
- 03. Government employees will not be entitled to maintain their pension rights whilst in the University Service.

## **BENEFITS**

Selected candidates will begin to contribute to the Universities Provident Fund by means of monthly deductions from his/ her salary and amount equal to ten percent (10%) of his/ her basic salary. The University will, in addition out of its funds contribute at the same time a sum equal to seven percent (07%) of his/ her earnings to the Universities Provident Fund and eight percent (08%) of his/ her earnings to the Pension Fund.
- 02. Three (03%) per centum of his/ her basic salary will be contributed by the University to the Employees Trust Fund in terms of Provision of the Employees Trust Fund.
