A Postgraduate Degree qualification (Master's) in Law / Social Sciences / Management or any other relevant field or Associate Membership of a recognized professional institution in Management.

AND

Minimum of 20 years' experience in "Managerial Level" out of which 05 years of experience should be at Senior Managerial Level with a proven track record in the Public or Provincial Service, Corporation, Statutory Board/Institute or a reputed private institution.

2. Full Membership of a recognized professional Chartered Institution in a related field

AND

Minimum of 15 years' experience at a "Managerial Level" in a Public or Provincial Service, Corporation, Statutory Board/Institute or a reputed private institution.

3. A Bachelor's degree recognized by UGC in Law / Social Sciences / Management or any other relevant field or Attorney-at-Law.

AND

PhD Degree in Law / Social Sciences / Management or any other relevant field.

AND

At least 05 years' experience at Senior Managerial Level with a proven track record and Management experience in the Public or Provincial Service, Corporation, Statutory Board or reputed Mercantile Establishment after obtaining first degree.

Note: Knowledge of Human Rights will be an added advantage

2. **Salary Scale :** Rs. 161,140-12 X 4,850-219,340 (HM 2-1-2025)

According to the MSD Circular No. 01/202 as at 01.01.2025,
Basic salary is Rs. 119,494/- + Cost of living allowance of Rs. 17,800/-

(Salary is determined in accordance with Public Administration Circular No. 03/2018 for retired government officers).

3. **Other:**

Every applicant,

- i. Should be a citizen of Sri Lanka.
- ii. Be **not less than 35 years and not more than 55 years** of age.
(Retired government officers up to 65 years of age are eligible to apply)
- iii. Should be physically and mentally fit to perform the duties of the post.
- iv. Should be of excellent moral character.

2. Applicants currently employed in the **Government Service, Corporations, or Statutory Boards** must apply through their respective Heads of Departments, who should indicate that the officer will be released if selected.
3. Only applicants who meet the required qualifications and are accordingly shortlisted will be called for interview.
4. Certified photocopies of certificates to prove qualifications and experience must be attached to the application.
