Post of Technical Officer (Electrical)

01. Job Scope

The Technical Officer (Electrical Engineering) will be responsible for supporting the planning, design, implementation, operation, and maintenance of the airport's electrical systems. This includes infrastructure related to aerodrome and airfield lighting, power supply networks, illumination systems, energy management, renewable energy sources, standby power systems, emergency lighting, terminal electrical equipment and other utility electrical systems. The role requires ensuring systems meet safety, efficiency, reliability, and regulatory standards to facilitate uninterrupted airport operations.

02. Key Responsibilities

- Assist in the preparation of electrical system plans, layouts, and technical specifications for new installations and upgrades related to airport infrastructure.
- Support design review processes to ensure compliance with national electrical codes, aviation authority regulations, and airport operational requirements.
- Assist in coordinating and monitoring electrical projects from inception through to commissioning, ensuring alignment with project timelines and budgets.
- Provide technical input during procurement of electrical materials, equipment, and services.
- Conduct site inspections and quality checks to verify adherence to design specifications and safety standards.
- Support commissioning, testing, and handover activities of electrical systems and equipment.
- Operate, monitor, and maintain electrical systems including power distribution (HV/LV), aerodrome and airfield lighting systems, terminal electrical equipment, and backup power supplies.

- Conduct regular preventive maintenance and inspections to ensure system reliability and reduce downtime.
- Troubleshoot and resolve electrical faults promptly to minimize disruption to airport operations.
- Manage emergency lighting systems and standby power arrangements to ensure uninterrupted operations during power outages and to comply with aviation safety requirements.
- Monitor energy consumption and support initiatives for energy conservation and renewable energy integration.
- Ensure all electrical work adheres to airport safety protocols, electrical safety codes, and aviation regulatory standards
- Maintain accurate logs, reports, and technical documentation for electrical system status, maintenance activities, and incidents
- Support training and technical development of junior staff and contractors on safe and effective electrical practices
- Liaise with internal departments, airport authorities, contractors, and vendors to facilitate smooth electrical system operations and project execution
- Prepare technical reports, progress updates, and documentation for management review
- Respond to and manage electrical emergencies, coordinating rapid restoration of services
