01. Job Scope

: Air Traffic Safety Electronics Engineering Officer ensures serviceability and availability of Communication, Navigation, Surveillance (CNS) and Airport Security Systems that are identified to be under his/her purview and also being responsible with corrective and preventive maintenance of respective systems in accordance with the regulatory requirements and the objectives of the Company to ensure safety of Aircraft operations and associated services.
