

- Identify any current or potential financial risks, emerging trends, financial sensitivities of the client.
- Review of Client's Capital (equity and debt) structure.
- Financial forecasting on need basis.
- Peer comparison of wholesale banking and project finance client financial performance to facilitate decision making
- Evaluate Client's overall borrowing status (including lending from other financial institutions)
- Review Bank's control over clients' cash flows.
- Present the above analysis, findings, suitable relationship strategies and recommendations in an independent report to the Relationship Manager after obtaining concurrence from the Chief Manager – Financial Analysis Unit.
- Planning above analysis to be completed in line with annual reviews of companies with the assistance of Relationship Manager.
- Gathering required information for above analysis from internal and external sources and client visits.
- Compile Industry evaluation reports to identify growth / declining sectors.
- Carryout specifically focused industry deep dives.
