A Postgraduate Degree qualification (Masters') in the field of Aviation or Associate Membership of a recognized Professional Chartered Institute relating to Aviation or successfully completed courses (Managerial Level) of not less than six (06) weeks in the field of Flight Safety/Personnel Licensing conducted by the International Civil Aviation Organization or similar Organization of International repute or any similar qualification which is recognized by the International Civil Aviation organization; AND
- Minimum of ten (10) years' experience as a Commercial Pilot, Flight Dispatcher, Aircraft Maintenance Engineer or an Air Traffic Controller with full privileges in Air Traffic Control in a Corporation, Statutory Board/Institution/Government owned company or a reputed Private Institution

Option 2

- Full Membership of a recognized Professional Chartered Institute relating to Aviation or successfully competition courses on Personnel Licenses including Government Safety/Personnel Licensing Inspector Course (Managerial Level) of not less than six (06) weeks conducted by the International Civil Aviation Organization or similar Organization of International repute or any similar qualification which is recognized by the International Civil Aviation Organization AND
- A Minimum of fifteen (15) years' experience as a Commercial Pilot, Air Traffic Controller with full privileges or an Aircraft Maintenance Engineer, Flight Dispatcher in a Corporation, Statutory Board/ Institution/Government Owned Company or a reputed Private Institution.
