Post of Instructor in Computer Technology - Grade II

The Gampaha Wickramarachchi University of Indigenous Medicine, Sri Lanka, will entertain applications from suitability qualified persons for the above post up to 03.12.2025.

QUALIFICATIONS:

(i) A First or Second class in the B. Sc. Special Degree in Computer Science/Computer Engineering from a recognized University.

OR

(ii) (a) A pass in the B. Sc Special Degree in Computer Science/Computer Engineering from a recognized University.

OR

A first or second class in the B. Sc. General Degree with Computing as a subject component from a recognized University.

AND

(b) One year experience in the field of Computing.

OR

(iii) (a) A pass in the B. Sc. General Degree with Computing as a subject component from a recognized University.

OR

A First or Second class in the B.Sc. General Degree (where Computing is not a subject component) from a recognized University.

<u>AND</u>

(b) Two years experience in the field of Computing.

<u>OR</u>

(iv) A pass in the B. Sc. General Degree (where Computing is not a subject component) from a recognized University.

AND

Three years experience in the field of Computing.

<u>OR</u>

(v) Any other Degree.

AND

A Postgraduate Diploma in Computer Science/ Computer Technology from a recognized University.

AND

One year experience in the field of Computing.

SALARY SCALE:

Instructor in Computer Technology Grade II:-

The above salary scale is fully operative with effect from 01.01.2027, and the placement of the salary applicable to the post for the year 01.01.2025 and 01.01.2026 will be made in accordance with the University Grants Commission Circular no.02/2025 (i)dated 04.04.2025

BENEFITS:

All permanent Appointees will become contributors to the Universities Provident Fund, contributing 10% of their monthly earnings and the University contributing an amount equivalent to 7%. In addition, they will become contributors to the Employees' Trust Fund and the University Pension Scheme, under which the University will contribute 3% and 8% of the monthly earnings of the employees, respectively. Appointees will also be entitled to receive other allowances as approved by the Government.
