- > The holders of the posts of Senior Lecturer Grade II and above are eligible for one-year Sabbatical Leave with full pay or two years of leave without pay on completion of seven years of service. Further, those proceeding abroad during the sabbatical leave period are eligible to receive full air passage for self and spouse.
