For each post advertised a separate application should be submitted.

Hard copies of the downloaded applications with original signatures and rubber stamps, uploaded certificates and Form A should be sent to reach Senior Assistant Registrar, Academic Establishments Division, University of Moratuwa, Katubedda, Moratuwa by mentioning the post applied on the top left hand corner of the envelope on or before the closing date of applications.

Applicants from the University System/Government Departments/Ministries/Corporations and Statutory Boards should channel their applications through the Head of their respective Institutions.

Applications and all the relevant documents received after the closing date and incomplete applications and applications not submitted in prescribed format of the University of Moratuwa will be rejected without intimation.

1. Analytical Chemist - Department of Civil Engineering / Department of Materials Science & Engineering

QUALIFICATIONS:

- A first or second class in the General Degree with Chemistry as a subject or Special Degree in Chemistry.

OR

- A pass in the Special Degree in Chemistry.

OR

- A pass in the General Degree with Chemistry as a subject with Postgraduate or professional qualifications.

2. Programmer cum Systems Analyst Grade II - Department of Computer Science & Engineering / Undergraduate Studies Division of the Faculty of Engineering / Dean's Office of the Faculty of Information Technology

QUALIFICATIONS:

- (i) A first or second class in the B.Sc. Special Degree in Computer Science/ Computer Engineering from a recognised University.

OR

- (ii) (a) A pass in the B.Sc. Special Degree in Computer Science/ Computer Engineering from a recognised University.

OR

A first or second class in the B.Sc. General Degree with Computing as a subject component from a recognised University.

AND

(b) One year experience in the field of Computing.

OR

(iii) (a) A pass in the B.Sc. General Degree with Computing as a subject component from a recognised University.

OR

A first or second class in the B.Sc. General Degree (where Computing is not a subject component) from a recognised University.

AND

(b) Two years experience in the field of Computing.

OR

(iv) A pass in the B.Sc. General Degree (where Computing is not a subject component) from a recognised University.

AND

Three years experience in the field of Computing.

OR

(v) Any other degree.

AND

A Postgraduate Diploma in Computer Science/ Computer Technology from a recognised University.

AND

One year experience in the field of Computing.

OR

(vi) 15 years experience as a Computer Programmer in the University Service.

3. Instructor (Computer Technology) Grade II – Department of Computer Science & Engineering / Department of Information Technology

QUALIFICATIONS:

(i) A first or second class in the B.Sc. Special Degree in Computer Science/ Computer Engineering from a recognised University.

OR

(ii) (a) A pass in the B.Sc. Special Degree in Computer Science/ Computer Engineering from a recognised University.

OR

A first or second class in the B.Sc. General Degree with Computing as a subject component from a recognised University.

AND

(b) One year experience in the field of Computing.

OR

(iii) (a) A pass in the B.Sc. General Degree with Computing as a subject component from a recognised University.

OR

A first or second class in the B.Sc. General Degree (where Computing is not a subject component) from a recognised University.

AND

(b) Two years experience in the field of Computing.

OR

(iv) A pass in the B.Sc. General Degree (where Computing is not a subject component) from a recognised University.

AND

Three years experience in the field of Computing.

OR

(v) Any other degree.

AND

A Postgraduate Diploma in Computer Science/ Computer Technology from a recognised University.

AND

One year experience in the field of Computing.

4. Engineer (Computer Maintenance) Grade III – Dean’s Office of the Faculty of Information Technology

QUALIFICATIONS:

(i) A Degree in Computer Science, Computer Engineering, Electrical/Electronics Engineering or related field.

OR

An equivalent professional qualification (ie: Appropriate Membership in BCS, IEE, IESL etc.).

AND

(ii) Experience in repairs and maintenance of Computer and/or electronic equipment.

5. Scientific Assistant Grade II - Faculty of Graduate Studies

Preference will be given to those who have experience in following areas:

Engineering, Business, Architecture, Information Technology and Medicine

QUALIFICATIONS:

(i) A first or second class (Upper Division) in a Special Degree Examination in the relevant subject.

OR

(ii) A second class (Lower Division) in a Special Degree Examination in the relevant subject.

OR

(iii) A pass in the BA/B.Sc. Special Degree Examination in the relevant subject.

OR

(iv) A pass in the BA/B.Sc. General Degree Examination with a recognised postgraduate qualification in the relevant subject.

SALARY SCALES:

- Analytical Chemist / Programmer cum Systems Analyst Grade II / Instructor (Computer Technology) Grade II / Engineer (Computer Maintenance) Grade III
- Rs.85,305 – 3x2,400 – 92,505 (EB) 94,905 - 14x2,400 – 128,505 p.m. [U-AS 2(II)], will be placed on the initial salary step of Rs. 85,305/- p.m. Monthly Compensatory Allowance# of 36% - Rs. 330/- of salary will be paid.
- Scientific Assistant Grade II- Rs.81,285 – 19x1,240– 104,845 p.m. [U-AS 1(I)]
will be placed on the initial salary step of Rs. 81,285/- p.m. Monthly Compensatory Allowance# of 36% - Rs. 330/- of salary will be paid.

Salary and Allowance will be paid according to the Commission Circular No. 02/2025 dated 01.04.2025.

In addition to the above salary, cost of living allowance and other approved allowances will be paid to the selected candidate/s.

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE:

01. These Posts are permanent. The appointment will be probation for a period of three (03) years.
02. Selected candidates, if presently serving in Government Departments will have to obtain their release through the Ministry of Public Administration. Government servants will not be entitled to maintain their pension rights whilst in the University Service.
03. Selected candidates, will become contributors to the Universities provident Fund by means of monthly deductions from his/her salary an amount equal to ten (10%) percentum of his/her earnings. The University will, in addition out of its funds contribute at the same time a sum equal to seven (7%) percentum of his/her earnings to the Universities Provident Fund and eight (8%) percentum of his/her earnings to the Pension Fund.
04. Three percentum (3%) of the earnings will be contributed by the University to the Employees Trust Fund in terms of the Provisions of the Employees Trust Act No. 46 of 1980.
05. Other conditions of appointment will be in accordance with the provisions of the Universities Act No. 16 of 1978 and subsequent amendments and Ordinances, Regulations, Rules, etc., made thereunder.
06. Applicants from the University System/Government Departments/Corporations and Statutory Boards should apply through the Heads of their respective Institutions.
