

Posts of Instructor in Physical Education Grade II / III

The University of Moratuwa, Sri Lanka will entertain applications for the Posts of Instructor in Physical Education Grade II/ III in the **University of Moratuwa** from among persons who hold the following qualifications.

Applications should be sent Online. Further particulars and application forms along with the handout could be downloaded from the University web site – <https://uom.lk/vacancies> up to **24th April, 2026**.

For each post advertised a separate application should be submitted.

Hard copies of the downloaded applications with original signatures and rubber stamps, uploaded certificates should be sent to reach Senior Assistant Registrar, Academic Establishments Division, University of Moratuwa, Katubedda, Moratuwa by mentioning the post applied on the top left hand corner of the envelope on or before the closing date of applications.

Applicants from the University System/Government Departments/Ministries/Corporations and Statutory Boards should channel their applications through the Head of their respective Institutions.

Applications and all the relevant documents received after the closing date and incomplete applications and applications not submitted in prescribed format of the University of Moratuwa will be rejected without intimation.

1. Instructor in Physical Education Grade II

QUALIFICATIONS:

- a) A degree in Physical Education of a recognized University or equivalent or higher qualifications in Physical Education with at least 05 years experience in the organization and implementation of recreational programmes after obtaining such degree;

OR

- b) A graduate of a recognized university who had been a member of a National Team representing the country or a National Champion with at least 06 years experience in the organization and implementation of recreational programmes.

OR

- c) Instructor in Physical Education with not less than 08 years service in that grade who had been a member of a National Team.

2. Instructor in Physical Education Grade III

QUALIFICATIONS:

- a) A graduate of a recognized university who has been a member of a National Team/ National Champion or other equivalent attainments in the field of sports with the prior approval of the UGC.

OR

- b) A candidate who has passed the G.C.E. (A/L) Examination in one and the same sitting and who has represented Sri Lanka in any sport at International Level with five (05) years experience in such sports.

OR

- c) G.C.E. (A/L) Examination in at least 03 subjects in one and the same sitting and a Diploma in Sports of not less than 09 months duration with five (05) years experience in organizing and implementing sports programmes.

Notes:

- (i) **Documentary evidence should be submitted to prove the five (05) years experience from the governing body of such sports/ Organization as the case may be.**
- (ii) **Candidates with other equivalent attainments in the field of sports as mentioned in qualification (a) above are considered if such qualifications are approved by the UGC.**

SALARY SCALES:

- d) Instructor in Physical Education Grade II
- Rs. 81,285 – 19x1,240 – 104,845 p.m. [U-AS 1(I)], will be placed on the initial salary step of Rs. 81,285/- p.m. Monthly Compensatory Allowance# of 36% - Rs. 330/- of salary will be paid.
- e) Instructor in Physical Education Grade III
- Rs. 68,145 – 18x1,190 – 89,565 p.m. [U-AS 1(II)] will be placed on the initial salary step of Rs. 68,145/- p.m. Monthly Compensatory Allowance# of 36% - Rs. 330/- of salary will be paid.

Salary and Allowance will be paid according to the Commission Circular No. 02/2025 dated 01.04.2025 and Commission Circular No. 02/2025 (i) dated 04.04.2025.

In addition to the above salary, cost of living allowance and other approved allowances will be paid to the selected candidate/s.

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE:

01. These Posts are permanent. The appointment will be probation for a period of three (03) years.
02. Selected candidates, if presently serving in Government Departments will have to obtain their release through the Ministry of Public Administration. Government servants will not be entitled to maintain their pension rights whilst in the University Service.
03. A Selected candidate will become a contributor to the Universities provident Fund by means of monthly deductions from his/her salary an amount equal to ten (10%) percentum of his/her earnings. The University will, in addition out of its funds contribute at the same time a sum equal to seven (7%) percentum of his/her earnings to the Universities Provident Fund and eight (8%) percentum of his/her earnings to the Pension Fund.
04. Three percentum (3%) of the earnings will be contributed by the University to the Employees Trust Fund in terms of the Provisions of the Employees Trust Act No. 46 of 1980.

05. Other conditions of appointment will be in accordance with the provisions of the Universities Act No. 16 of 1978 and subsequent amendments and Ordinances, Regulations, Rules, etc., made thereunder.
06. Applicants from the University System/Government Departments/Corporations and Statutory Boards should apply through the Heads of their respective Institutions.
