1. Having obtained proficiency certificate not below that the National Vocational Qualification Level 2, issued by a Technical/ Vocational Training Institute accepted by the Tertiary and Vocational Education Commission, relevant to the function of each post.

2. Passed Six (06) subject at the G.C.E.(O/L) examination with three (03) credit.

Internal Applicants (Qualifications 1 or 2 or 3 below)

1. Employees in unskilled level(PL-1) who have completed a minimum of five (05) years working experience in the relevant field with skills not below than the National Vocational Qualification Level 2, proven at a trade test
2. Having obtained proficiency certificate not below that the National Vocational Qualification Level 2, issued by a Technical/ Vocational Training Institute accepted by the Tertiary and Vocational Education Commission, relevant to the function of each post.
3. Passed Six (06) subject at the G.C.E.(O/L) examination with three (03) credit passes.

Age: Should not be less than 18 years and not more than 45 years. The upper age limit will not apply to the internal candidates.
