At least 10 years of experience in the relevant field at a managerial level, out of which 05 years should be at a senior managerial level.

Corporate/Fellow Membership obtained from a recognized professional body in the relevant field.

At least 08 years of experience in the relevant field at a managerial level, out of which 04 years should be at a senior managerial level.

- ☞ Lead, coordinate and supervise the performance of consultants, contractors, subcontractors, suppliers, third-party inspectors and all associated stakeholders involved in the project.
- ☞ Develop and implement project execution strategies, work plans, resource allocation and staffing arrangements for all phases, from design through commissioning and handover.
- ☞ Administer the project in accordance with the conditions of contract, employer's requirements, technical specifications and applicable international standards.
- ☞ Monitor and control project progress, cost, quality, safety and risks to ensure timely and efficient completion.
- ☞ Review and oversee engineering designs, technical submissions, drawings, methodologies and construction procedures to ensure technical integrity and compliance with industry standards.

- ☞ Manage contractual and commercial matters including variations, claims, disputes, extension of time requests, negotiations with contractors and stakeholders.
- ☞ Ensure effective coordination and interface management across all project components including fuel storage tanks, pipelines, pumping systems, utilities, firefighting systems, electrical and instrumentation systems and associated infrastructures.

- ☞ Oversee pre-commissioning, commissioning, performance testing, operational readiness and final handover, ensuring all technical and contractual requirements are fulfilled.
- ☞ Prepare and submit periodic progress reports, management reports, Board papers, presentations and recommendations to the management and Board of Directors of CPC and perform any other duties assigned by the management in relation to the Project.

The Project will contribute 12% of the salary towards the EPF whilst the employee will have to contribute 8%. The Project will also contribute 3% of the salary towards the ETF.


#### **HOW TO APPLY**
