The Postgraduate Institute of Medicine, University of Colombo will entertain Applications from suitably qualified persons for the following Post up to 03.07.2026.

Applicants should possess an MBBS degree, and preference will be given to those who have obtained an MD with Board Certification in Health Informatics.

01. EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS:

(A). Lecturer (Probationary)

- (01) MBBS/BDS Degree with First or Second Class (Upper Division) Honours and at least one (01) year of experience in teaching/research/professional work/postgraduate studies.

OR

- (02) MBBS/BDS Degree with Second Class (Lower Division) Honours and at least one (01) year of experience in teaching/research/professional work/postgraduate studies.

(B). Lecturer (Unconfirmed)

- (1) (i) MBBS/BDS Degree with First or Second Class (Upper Division) Honours and at least one (01) year of experience in teaching/research/professional work/ postgraduate studies.

OR

- (ii) MBBS/BDS Degree with Second Class (Lower Division) Honours and at least one (01) year of experience in Teaching / research/ professional work / postgraduate studies.

OR

- (iii) MBBS Degree

And

- (a) A Doctoral Degree in the relevant field.

OR

- (b) A Masters Degree in the relevant field with full time research of at least 24 months duration

OR

- (iv) Such academic or professional qualifications or professional experience as may be approved by the University Grants Commission upon recommendation of the University of Colombo

AND

- (2) (i) (a) A MD/MS and **awaiting Board Certification** of the Postgraduate Institute of Medicine (PGIM)

or

- (b) A Doctoral Degree in the relevant field.

or

- (c) A Masters Degree in the relevant field with full time research of at least 24 months duration

OR

- (ii) Such professional qualifications and experience as may be approved by the University Grants Commission upon recommendation of the University of Colombo

(C). Senior Lecturer – Grade II

- (01) MBBS/BDS Degree with First or Second Class (Upper Division) Honours; and at least one (01) year of experience in teaching/research/professional work/postgraduate studies.

OR

- (02) MBBS/BDS Degree with Second Class (Lower Division) Honours and at least one (01) year of experience in teaching/research/professional work/postgraduate studies.

OR

- (03) MBBS /BDS Degree and a Postgraduate Degree of at least two academic years' duration in the relevant subject with a research component by way of thesis / dissertation.

OR

- (04) Such academic or professional qualifications or professional experience as may be approved by the University Grants Commission upon the recommendation of the Higher Educational Institution concerned.

AND

- (1) A Masters Degree in the relevant field obtained after a full-time course of study of at least 02 academic years (or an equivalent part-time course of study) with a research component by way of thesis/dissertation or a Doctoral Degree or MD/MS and Board Certification by the Postgraduate Institute of Medicine where required or its equivalent.

OR

- (2) Such professional qualifications and experience as may be approved by the University Grants Commission upon the recommendation of the Higher Educational Institution concerned.

AND

At least six (06) years of experience in one or more of the following:

- (i) Teaching at University level
- (ii) Professional experience
- (iii) Research in a recognized Institution
- (iv) Postgraduate Studies to acquire the qualifications stipulated at (2) above.

(D). Senior Lecturer Grade I

01. Candidates should possess the academic qualifications required for Lecturer (Probationary) (Medical/Dental) as per UGC Circular No. 721 and other relevant circulars.

AND

- 02.(i) A Masters Degree in the relevant field obtained after a full-time course of study of at least 02 academic years (or an equivalent part-time course of study) with a research component by way of thesis/dissertation or a Doctoral Degree or MD/MS and Board Certification by the Postgraduate Institute of Medicine where required or its equivalent.

OR

- (ii) Such professional qualifications and experience as may be approved by the University Grants Commission upon the recommendation of the Higher Educational Institution concerned.

AND

03. At least eleven (11) years of experience (of which not less than six (06) years should have been after obtaining the qualifications stipulated in 02 above) in one or more of the following:

- (i) Teaching at University level
- (ii) Professional experience
- (iii) Research in a recognized Institution
- (iv) Postgraduate Studies

***Preference will be given to candidates with a good track record in Research.**

02. SALARY AND OTHER CONDITIONS OF APPOINTMENT:

According to the UGC Circular No. 02/2025 salary scales revised w.e.f. 01.01.2025 as follows;

In addition to the above salary Academic Allowance, Cost of Living Allowance and other approved allowances will also be paid.

The selected candidate will be a member of the Universities Provident Fund as well as of the University Pension Scheme. He/ She will contribute 10% of his/her monthly salary to the Universities Provident Fund and at the same time the employer will make a total contribution of 15% of his/her salary of which 8% will be credited to the Universities Pension Fund and 7% to the Universities Provident Fund. Three percent (3%) of the salary will be contributed by the University to the Employee' Trust Fund in terms of the provisions of the Employees' Trust Fund Act, No. 46 of 1980.

The other conditions of appointment will be in accordance with provisions of the Universities Act. No. 16 of 1978, and its subsequent amendments and PGIM Ordinance, By-Laws, Regulations and Rules etc., made there under.
