



## **RAJARATA UNIVERSITY OF SRI LANKA POST OF DEPUTY VICE CHANCELLOR**

The Council of the Rajarata University of Sri Lanka invites applications from permanent academic staff members holding the grade of Senior Lecturer Grade I or above for the post of Deputy Vice-Chancellor of the University.

In accordance with the provisions of the Universities Act No. 16 of 1978, as amended, and any directions issued by the Council from time to time, the Deputy Vice-Chancellor shall act under the direction and guidance of the Vice-Chancellor. The appointee will assist the Vice-Chancellor in the exercise, performance, and discharge of the powers, duties, and functions assigned under the Act or any other relevant instruments. The Deputy Vice-Chancellor is expected to play a key role, among other responsibilities, in the planning, organization, and management of student services, student counselling, and student discipline.

The selected candidate will be entitled to the salary and allowances applicable to the post of Professor. In addition, the allowances attached to the applicant's substantive post will continue to be paid, together with any other entitlements in terms of University Grants Commission Circular No. 676 and Establishments Circular Letter No. 06/2014 (i). If a Senior Professor is appointed, he or she will continue to receive the salary and allowances applicable to his or her substantive post.

Duly completed applications, together with a comprehensive curriculum vitae, should be forwarded through the proper channel under confidential cover to the Vice Chancellor, Rajarata University of Sri Lanka, to reach on or before 3.00 p.m. on 14<sup>th</sup> August 2026.
