Note: -

- Every applicant,
 - Should be a citizen of Sri Lanka.
 - Should be physically and mentally fit to discharge duties well in the post and serve in any part of the Island.
 - Should be of excellent moral character.
- Only Buddhist monks are eligible to apply for the post of Senior Lecturer Grade I/II, Lecturer (Unconfirmed), and Lecturer (Probationary). Preference will be given to applicants who have obtained their first degree in English medium and have specialized in Tipitaka Studies. The ability to teach in English is an essential requirement for these posts.
- Applicants appointed to the posts of Senior Lecturer Grade I/II, Lecturer (Unconfirmed), or Lecturer (Probationary) shall be required to serve the University for a minimum period of ten (10) years and enter into an agreement with the University to that effect.
- For the non-academic posts, only lay persons are eligible to apply.
- For the post of Driver, preference will be given to candidates residing in the Anuradhapura District.
- Age Limits -
 - For the post of Management Assistant - shall be not less than 18 years and not more than 30 years of age as at the closing date for applications
 - For the other non-academic posts, applicants shall be not less than 18 years and not more than 45 years of age as at the closing date for applications
 - The upper age limit shall not apply to internal candidates
- The qualification details of all the above posts, as indicated in the relevant Scheme of Recruitment(SOR) can be obtained from the University's website: **www.busl.ac.lk**.

Benefits

- In addition to the above salary, any other allowances approved by the University Grants Commission will also be paid to the relevant staff members.
- Those who join the University will become members of the University Provident Fund (UPF) and the ten percent (10%) of the salary will be credited by the employees and fifteen percent (15%) will be credited by the University. Three percent (3%) of the salary will be credited to the Employees Trust Fund (ETF) by the University.
- Academic posts are entitled for study leave with pay and without pay as per the provisions of the Establishment Code of the University Grants Commission and the Higher Educational Institutions (2023).
- All appointees to the posts of Senior Lecturer Grade I and Senior Lecturer Grade II shall be entitled to Sabbatical Leave in accordance with the provisions stipulated in the Establishment Code of the University Grants Commission and the Higher Educational Institutions (2023).

Applications

- Prescribed application forms and relevant information can be obtained from the Assistant Registrar (Establishments) by hand or by post by sending a self-addressed, stamped Rs. 50.00 envelope of size 23 cm × 10 cm to the Assistant Registrar (Establishments) on or before 20.08.2026. The application forms can also be downloaded from the University's website: **www.busl.ac.lk**
- Candidates who apply for more than one post should submit separate applications for each post.
- The qualifying date shall be the closing date for applications.

How to Apply

- Duly completed application forms shall be forwarded under registered post along with copies of certificates and other relevant documents as specified in the application form and in accordance with the qualifications indicated in the relevant circulars. The post applied for should be clearly indicated on the top left-hand corner of the envelope. Applications shall be addressed to the **Assistant Registrar (Establishments), Bhiksu University of Sri Lanka, Puttalam Road, Anuradhapura**, and shall be received on or before **02nd September 2026**.
- Candidates serving in Universities, Government Departments, State Corporations, and Statutory Bodies shall forward their applications through the Heads of their respective Institutions. Applications forwarded through the respective Heads of Institutions shall be accepted by the University within 14 days from the closing date of applications (from 02.09.2026 to 16.09.2026), considering the official forwarding process. Applications which are not forwarded through the respective Heads of Departments will be rejected.
- Applications received after the closing date, incomplete applications, applications not conforming to the above conditions, or applications not submitted in the prescribed format for the relevant post as specified by the Bhiksu University of Sri Lanka shall be rejected without prior notice.
- The University reserves the right to shortlist only the qualified candidates and call them for interviews.
