Calling of Applications for Re-scrutiny

1. Applications are calling only via online for re-scrutiny of results of the above examination.
2. The applications should be submitted by school and private candidates by themselves.
3. Applications for re-scrutiny will be received **from 25.06.2026 to 08.07.2026**.
4. Use one of the following methods to apply for re-scrutiny of results:
 - ❖ Log into the official website of the Department of Examinations **<https://doenets.lk>** and click on to “Exam Information Centre” which is under “Our Services”.
 - ❖ Log into **<https://onlineexams.gov.lk/eic>**
5. **If you already have a user profile, you are instructed to use the same Index Number and National Identity Card Number, which you have used for sitting for the G.C.E. (O/L) Examination - 2025(2026). If not, register yourself by entering your National Identity Card Number and Contact Number.**
6. Before completing the application, reading technical instruction sheet and watching the explanatory video on filling the application, is necessary to fill the application accurately.
7. The fee for the re-scrutiny per subject is Rs. 200/= . This amount can be paid by a credit/debit card or to a post office.
8. PDF format of the application can be downloaded after the payment and it should be kept with you. Also, you will receive a SMS to your mobile phone after paying the relevant amount.
9. It is the responsibility of the candidate to enter all the subjects wish to apply for re-scrutiny accurately. A candidate can apply only once through the online application. The applications without the relevant payment will be rejected without further notice. The amount paid for the application is non-refundable.
