1. General Qualifications required :

1:1 Every applicant must furnish satisfactory proof that he is a Sri Lankan. A Sri Lankan, is a citizen of Sri Lanka by descent or by registration as defined in the Sri Lanka Citizenship Act.

1:2 A candidate for any post for which the minimum educational qualification prescribed is a pass in the Senior School Certificate Examination or equivalent or higher examination, should have a pass in the Senior School Certificate Examination or equivalent or higher examination, should have a pass either in Sinhala language or Tamil language obtained, as the case may be, at the Senior School Certificate Examination or its equivalent if he is either a Sinhalese educated in Sinhala Medium or if he is a Tamil educated in Tamil Medium (This requirement will not apply to those who are in the public service from a date prior to January 01, 1961, and who seek appointments to other posts in the public service).

1:3 Application from the New Entrants, Public Officers, who are not either Sinhala or Tamil educated, whose probationary trial appointments have been terminated for failure to pass the prescribed official language proficiency tests will not be entertained unless they have obtained the qualifications which could entitle them to seek exemptions from the highest proficiency test prescribed for the post.

2. Conditions of Service-General :

2:1 All officers in the Public Service will be subject to the Financial Regulations, the Establishments Code, Departmental Orders or Regulations and any other Orders or Regulations that may be issued by the Governments from time to time.

2:2 A Public officer may be required to furnish security in terms of the Public Officers (Security) Ordinance, in such sum and in such manner as the secretary to the Ministry concerned may determine.

2:3 A Public Officer may be called upon to serve in any part of the Island.

3. Conditions of Service applicable to Public Officers holding permanent appointments :

3:1 In addition to the conditions referred to in Section 2 above Public Officer holding permanent appointments will be subject to the following further conditions:

3:1:1 All appointments will be on probation for a period of 3 years unless a longer period is considered necessary in respect of any post. Any appointment may be terminated at any time during the period of probation without a reason being assigned.

3:1:2 All public officers are required to conform to the provisions of the Chapter IV of the Constitution of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka and any other laws, regulations or rules that may be made from time to time to give effect to the Language Policy of the Government.

3:1:3 All Public officers who have not entered the Public Service either in Sinhala Medium or in Tamil Medium are required to acquire a working knowledge in one of the official languages.

3:1:4 Confirmation at the expiry of the period of probation of an officer who entered the Public Service in a medium other than Sinhala or Tamil will depend, inter alia, on the passing of the Grade I Proficiency Test in one of the Official Languages within one year; Grade II Proficiency Test within two years, and Grade III Proficiency Test (where applicable) within three years from the date of appointment.

Failure to pass a test within the prescribed period will result in the suspension of increments. Suspension will be converted to a stoppage if the test is not passed within a further period of six months beyond the prescribed period such stoppage operating until the test is passed or until such time as the provisions of Section 3:1:6 below apply.

3:1:5 Such officers should, on receiving appointment, be given facilities on full pay, for a period of 6 months to obtain proficiency in one of the official languages. He will thereafter, be required to sit the relevant proficiency examination and if he does not pass he will be given the opportunity to pass the examination within a period of 2 years immediately after the period of 6 months on full pay, while he performs his normal duties.

3:1:6 If he fails to pass the examination in this prescribed period of 2 1/2 years his services will be terminated.

3:1:7 A Public Officer already confirmed in permanent post in the Public Service will not normally be required to serve the period of probation on being appointed to another permanent post in the Public Service. Such Officers may in the first instance be appointed to act in the new post for a

specified period with a view to testing him in his new post.

3:1:8 Selected candidates (Other than those already holding permanent or temporary appointments in the Public Service) who have already been medically examined will be required to undergo a medical examination by a Government Medical Officer to test their physical fitness to serve in any part of the Island.

4. Terms of Engagement :

4:1 Public officers appointed to permanent and pensionable posts should contribute to the 'Widows and Orphans' Pension Scheme from their salary an amount equivalent to the percentage the Government requires to recover from their salary.

4:2 Public officers appointed to permanent or temporary posts on Provident Fund basis will be required to contribute 6% of their consolidated salary to the Public Service Provident Fund. The Government will contribute as its share of contributions an amount equal to 150% of the compulsory contributions credited to the fund at the close of the Financial Year.

4:3 Officers who hold pensionable appointments in the Public Service and who are released for appointments to pensionable posts in the Local Government Service and those officers in the Local Government Service who hold pensionable appointments and who are released for appointments to pensionable posts in the Public Service will be allowed pensionability in their posts in the Local Government Service and Public Service respectively.

4:4 Regular Force personnel in the Army, Navy and Air Force who are released for appointments to posts in the Public Service which are pensionable under the Minutes on Pension will be allowed pensionability in their posts in the Public Service. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in these Minutes the unforfeited full pay service of any member of the Armed Forces who is released to accept an appointment as a Public Officer in a post which has been declared to be pensionable under these Minutes shall be reckoned for the purpose of any pension or gratuity payable under these Minutes.

5. Serving Officers in the Public Service :

5:1 Applications from officers of the Public Service who possess all the necessary qualifications must be forwarded through the Heads of their respective Departments. In the case of applications from Public Officers holding post in the permanent establishment in the Public Service. Heads of Departments in forwarding such applications should state whether the applicants could be released or not to take up the new appointment, if selected.

5:2 Candidates may be required to present themselves for interview at an appointed time and place. No travelling or other expenses will be paid in this connection.

5:3 Anyone desiring to recommend a candidate should do so by giving a testimonial. Any form of canvassing or any attempt to influence the selection of a candidate will disqualify such candidates.

5:4 Any statement in the application which is found to be incorrect will render the applicant liable to disqualification if the inaccuracy is discovered before the selection and to dismissal if discovered after the selection.

5:5 Application not conforming in every respect with the requirements of the advertisement will be rejected.

6. Definition of Salary for the purpose of Eligibility :

6:1 Salary for purposes of eligibility means only the consolidated salary and does not include any action salary, allowances etc.

7. New National Policy on Recruitment and Promotions :

Recruitment and Promotion in the Public Service, Provincial Public Service, Public Corporate Sector and Companies fully owned by the Government will be done in accordance with the policy laid down in the Public Administration Circulars No. 15/90 of 09.03.1990, 15/90 (I) of 25.03.1990 & 15/90 (ii) of 15.06.1990 with effect from 01.01.1990 subject to amendments that will be done by subsequent Public Administration Circulars.

Rules and Instructions for Candidates

All candidates are bound to act in conformity with the provisions of the Examinations Act, No. 25 of 1968.

All candidates are bound to abide by the rules given below. A candidate who violates any of these rules is liable to one or more of the following punishments at the discretion of the Commissioner of Examinations :—

- (i) Suspension from the whole or part of the examination or one subject or a part thereof ;
- (ii) Disqualification from one subject or from the whole examination ;
- (iii) Debarment from appearing for an examination for a period of one year or two years ;
- (iv) Debarment for life ;
- (v) Suspension of the certificate for a specified period ;
- (vi) Reporting the candidate's conduct to his Superiors or handing over the candidate to the Police or making a complaint to the Police over his action.

The Commissioner reserves himself the right to take action at any time before the Examination or at any stage of it or thereafter, and his decision shall be deemed final. In the case of examinations for recruitment to the Public Service, the decision of Commissioner of Examinations shall be subject to the Supervision of the Public Service Commission.

1. All candidates should conduct themselves in a quiet manner in and around the Examination Hall so as not to disturb or obstruct the Supervisor, his assistants or the other candidates. They should enter and leave the Examination Hall as quietly as possible.

2. Candidates should obey the Supervisor. Therefore, when the Examination is in progress and before the commencement of the Examination as well as immediately after the end of the Examination they should act in accordance with the instructions of the Supervisor and his assistants.

3. Under no circumstances whatsoever will a candidate be allowed into the Examination Hall after the lapse of half an hour after the commencement of a paper. No candidate will be permitted to leave the hall till after half an hour from the time of commencement of the paper. Candidates who come late for Practical and Oral Examinations are liable to be refused admission.

4. Every candidate should sit at the desk bearing his/her index number and not at any other desk. Unless with the permission of the supervisor no candidate should change his/her seat. The occupation of a seat other than the one assigned to him by a candidate is liable to be considered as an act with a dishonest intention.

5. Absolute silence should be maintained in the Examination Hall. A candidate is forbidden to speak to, communicate with or have dealings with any person within or outside the Examination Hall other than a member of the Examination Hall Staff. If there is an urgent need for a candidate to communicate with another, prior permission must be obtained from the supervisor.

6. A candidate's answer script is identified only by the Index Number and his/her name should not be written on the answer script. Another candidate's index number appearing on the answer script of a candidate is considered as an attempt to commit a dishonest act. Answer scripts bearing an index number that is difficult to decipher is liable to be rejected.

7. Candidates should write only on the paper provided and should not write anything on the blotting paper, question paper, desk or any other place. Non conformity with this rule could be taken as an act with dishonest intentions.

8. Any paper or answer book supplied should not be torn up, crushed, folded or erased. Each and every sheet of paper used for rough work should be tied up with the answer script. It should be a part of the answer script. (Such rough work should be neatly crossed out.) Anything written inside the Examination Hall should not be taken out. If a question has been answered twice, the unnecessary answer should be neatly crossed out. Failure to abide by these requirements may be considered as an attempt to cheat.

9. When answering questions in Mathematics the submission of correct answers with incorrect working or with no working at all and in art if the work of art is similar or very close in resemblance to that of another candidate in concept, in form or in execution it is liable to be considered as a dishonest act.

10. The removal of any paper or stationery supplied to candidates out of the Examination Hall is prohibited. All such material remains the property of the Commissioner of Examinations. Breach of this rule shall be liable to be considered an act with dishonest intention.

11. While in the Examination Hall a candidate should not have with him or near him any book, note book, pocket note book, exercise book, sheet of paper or pieces of paper other than the stationery supplied to him. Nor should any handbag, travelling bag or parcel other than the candidate's boxes of colours and boxes of instruments where necessary or any file cover, card board pad, folded newspapers, brown papers should be brought into the Examination Hall. Breach of this rule is a punishable act.

12. A candidate is strictly forbidden to keep with him any book, note book or a sheet of paper with written notes once inside the Examination Hall. Should the Supervisor so requires, each candidate is bound to

declare everything he has with him/her. Breach of this requirement shall be considered as an attempt to commit an act of dishonesty.

13. Candidates are forbidden to copy or attempt to copy from the answer script of another candidate, a book, paper containing notes or any other source. A candidate should not attempt to look at the answer script of any another candidate. A candidate should refrain from helping another Candidate and also from getting help from another candidate or a person. Every completed answer sheet should be kept underneath the sheet on which the answer is being written. Sheets of writing paper should not be strewn all over the desk.

14. A candidate will under no circumstance whatsoever be allowed to leave the Examination Hall even for a brief period during the course of the paper. However in an emergency if a candidate needs to leave the hall, he/she shall be allowed to do under the surveillance of the supervisor or his assistant. He/she shall be subject to search before leaving the hall as well as before re-entering it.

15. Impersonation while answering a paper or before the commencement of the Examination is a punishable offence. Tampering with identity cards, presenting false identity cards or tampering with someone's identity are also such offences. Candidates are warned not to commit such offences.

16. Assistance given to a candidate in a dishonest manner by a person who is not a candidate, is considered a serious offence.

Candidates should adhere to the following instructions for their own safety :—

(i) Be at the Examination Hall well in time. It is sufficient to be at the Examination Hall 10 or 15 minutes before the commencement of each paper. If you have any doubt as to the location of the Examination Hall, make inquiries on a day prior to the date of Examination and be sure of its location.

(ii) In case of any doubt regarding your entry for a paper or eligibility to sit a paper you should bring it to the notice of the Supervisor and get your doubts cleared. Failure to do so may result in your candidature for the subject being cancelled.

(iii) When appearing for the Examination, candidates should produce their identity cards at every paper they sit. If a candidate fails to produce identification documents at the Examination Hall, his candidature is liable to be cancelled. In case a candidate forgets to bring such documents into the Examination Hall, it should be brought to the notice of the Supervisor and arrangements should be made to produce them before the Examination concludes.

(iv) Standard stationery (i.e. writing paper, graph paper, ledger paper, precis paper) will be supplied. If you receive any stationery that is different from the kind generally distributed or distributed to the others it should be promptly brought to the notice of the supervisor. No paper other than those issued at the Examination Hall should be used for answering questions. Excess paper and other material should be left on the desk, in good condition. When log tables are supplied they should be used with care and left on the desk when you leave.

(v) Candidates should bring their own pens, pencils, bottles of ink, erasers, pieces of cloth, rulers, geometrical instruments, coloured pencils, coloured chalk, etc.

(vi) When you start answering you should promptly write down your Index Number and the name of the Examination on each sheet of paper used. Write neatly and legibly on both sides of the paper. Leave a blank line after the answer to each part of a question. After the answer to a full question leave one or several blank lines. Do not crowd in your work.

(vii) The left-hand margin of the answer sheet is set apart for you to enter the number of the question you answer. The right hand margin is reserved for the examiner's use and nothing should be written there. Number your answers correctly as incorrect numbering leads to confusion.

(viii) You should read carefully the instructions given at the head of the question paper, with regard to the compulsory questions and the manner in which the other questions should be selected. Disregard to these instructions is often liable to affect you adversely.

(ix) When Mathematics Questions are answered, give all details of calculations and any roughwork, in their serial order as part of the working of the problem. Necessary sketches, diagrams and figures should be accurate and sufficiently large. In an answer running into several pages if reference must be made to a diagram drawn in an earlier page, that diagram should be drawn repeatedly.

(x) At the end of each paper, arrange your answer sheets in the order you answered the questions. Then using the piece of twine supplied, tie them up at the top left hand corner. Do not tie up at the top right hand corner.

(xi) You should personally handover your answer script to the Supervisor or to an Invigilator. Or else remain in your seat till it is collected. Failure to do so may result in the loss of your script and your being treated as an absentee for the paper. On no account should your script be handed over to a peon or an attendant.

(xii) If it becomes necessary for you to speak to the Supervisor or an Invigilator, or if you need stationery, remain in your seat and raise your hand.

Open Competitive Examination for Recruitment to Grade III of the Combined Drivers' Service - 2026

01. IT is hereby notified that the Open Competitive Examination for Recruitment to posts in Grade III of the Combined Drivers' Service will be conducted by the Commissioner General of Examinations in May 2026. The relevant application has been published on the official website of the Department of Examinations, Sri Lanka, www.doenets.lk and applications can strictly be submitted online. The closing date of applications is **16.03.2026**.

Note - The acceptance of online applications commences on 16.02.2026 at 9.00 a.m. and ends on 16.03.2026 at 9.00 p.m.

This examination will be conducted strictly at the examination centers established in the towns specified in Schedule - II. All applicants must select the town in which they intend to sit for the examination in accordance with the said schedule and the town of preference and its corresponding number must be accurately stated in accordance with Schedule – II when completing the online application.

02. Candidates who qualify based on merit in accordance with the results of a written test conducted by the Commissioner General of Examinations, will be selected for the interview to be considered for appointment to the posts in Grade III of the Combined Drivers' Service on the basis of district population ratios.

03.

(a) The number of appointments and the effective date of such appointments shall be determined by the Appointing Authority. The Appointing Authority reserves the power to refrain from filling any or all of the vacancies.

(b) A selected candidate shall be appointed to Grade III of the Combined Drivers' Service, subject to the general conditions governing appointments in the Public Service, the terms and conditions stipulated in the Minute of the Combined Drivers' Service published in the *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 1875/39 dated 15.08.2014 as amended by the *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 2467/75 dated 19.12.2025 and any further revisions made or to be made hereafter to the said Minute, the provisions of the Establishments Code and Financial Regulations and the Procedural Rules of the Public Service Commission published in the *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 2310/29 dated 14.12.2022.

(c) If selected for an appointment, it is compulsory to serve for a minimum period of three (03) years at the place of work of the first appointment. However, the Appointing Authority has the power to transfer an officer before the completion of the said period, if necessary, on special grounds determined by the Appointing Authority

(d) This appointment is subjected to a probation period of three years. The First Efficiency Bar Examination should be passed within 03 years from the date of appointment to Grade III of Combined Drivers' Service as specified in the Service Minute.

(e) In the event of being selected for an appointment, you shall be required to acquire the proficiency in the relevant Official Language in accordance with the language medium in which you satisfied the qualifications for the appointment, as per the provisions of Public Administration Circular No. 18/2020 dated 16.10.2020 and consequent circulars.

(f) It should also be noted that candidates selected for appointment are required to perform duties beyond regular working hours as per service requirements and shall be subjected to perform duties away from the office even for several consecutive days under available facilities, upon immediate notice based on service requirements.

Example :

- (i.) Performing duties during instances where essential services must be maintained.
- (ii.) Driving various types of vehicles and heavy vehicles based on service requirements.
- (iii.) Performing duties involving long distance travel for service requirements under accommodation provided with minimum facilities.
- (iv.) Performing duties involving overnight stays away from the regular place of work for several consecutive days.

04. The salary code PL 03-2025 prescribed in Public Administration Circular No. 10/2025 dated 25.03.2025 is applicable to this post and the salary scale relevant to the same is Rs. 42,780 - 10x490 - 11x540 - 10x590 - 12x630 – 66,540/-. A candidate selected for appointment shall be entitled to the said salary with effect from 01.01.2027 and salaries will be paid from the effective date of the appointment in accordance with the provisions of Schedule III of the said Circular.

05. This post is permanent and pensionable.

06. **Qualifications:**

6.1 Educational Qualifications :

Shall have passed six subjects in G.C.E. Ordinary Level with at least two credits including Sinhala/Tamil language at not more than two sittings.

- (i.) The language medium in which the applicant sits for this competitive examination shall be considered the language in which the applicant is required to have obtained a pass.
- (ii.) The final decision with regard to the acceptance of qualifications obtained by sitting for an examination equivalent to the General Certificate of Education (Ordinary Level) examination conducted by local or foreign educational institutions shall be made by the Director General of Combined Services, after obtaining confirmation from the relevant educational institutions and the Commissioner General of Examinations.

6.2 Professional Qualifications :

Shall possess a valid driving license for at least 'C' and 'C1' vehicle classes according to the old driving license classes issued by the Commissioner General of Motor Traffic for driving motor cars and dual-purpose vehicles, or a valid driving license for at least 'B' class according to the new driving license, obtained at least 03 years prior to the date of recruitment.

6.3 Experience :

Shall possess 3 years of experience after obtaining a driving license as a driver of motor vehicles. (Experience shall be verified by certificates.)

6.4 Physical Fitness :

- (i.) Shall be of the minimum height of 5 ft.
- (ii.) Shall be of sound physical health and good eye sight so as to perform duties during day and night. This should be proved by a proper certificate issued by a Government Medical Officer.

6.5 Other Qualifications :

- (a) Shall be a citizen of Sri Lanka.
- (b) Shall be not less than 18 years and not more than 45 years of age as at the closing date of applications. (Accordingly, only whose birthday falls on or before 16.03.2008 and on or after 16.03.1981 are eligible to apply.)

Note : Maximum age limit shall not be applicable for those who already hold permanent and pensionable posts in Public Service.

- (c) Shall be of excellent moral character.
- (d) Every candidate shall have the physical and mental fitness to serve in any part of the country and to perform the duties of the post.

N.B. – It is compulsory for every applicant to have satisfied all the relevant qualifications for the post on or before 16.03.2026.

07. Making selections based on the district population ratio.

The list of districts is indicated in Schedule - I. When filling the online application, candidates must accurately specify the district and its corresponding number under which they choose to compete for vacancies, as per Schedule – I.

(a) Recruitment to the service will be made on proportionate basis. A specific number of vacancies will be allocated to each administrative district in proportion to its population. Only the applicants applying from a particular district will be eligible to compete for the vacancies allocated to the said district based on the population ratio.

I. In the instances where the number of vacancies allocated to a certain district as mentioned above cannot be filled by qualified applicants from that district, such vacancies shall be reallocated among all adjacent districts in proportion to their respective population.

II. In case where the total number of vacancies to be filled is minimal and the basis of district population cannot be applied due to that reason, suitable candidates will be selected based on the order of merit.

III. In the instances where the number of candidates, who have secured the minimum marks, is less than the number of vacancies allocated, selection will not be made based on the district population ratio.

***N.B.* – The number of vacancies allocated to a district refers to the number of vacancies reserved for candidates appearing for the competitive examination from the said administrative district, in proportion to its population and it should be noted that this does not represent the actual number of vacancies in the Combined Drivers’ Service existing within government institutions located in that specific administrative district. Therefore, merely choosing a district to**

compete does not entitle any candidate to claim a vacancy in a Government Institution located within that same district.

(b) Requirements to compete under a district - A candidate must fulfill at least one of the following requirements to compete for the vacancies allocated to a specific district.

I. The candidate shall have been born in the district;

or

II. The candidate shall have been a permanent resident of the relevant district for at least three (03) consecutive years within the five (05) year period immediately preceding the closing date of applications;

or

III. The candidate shall have received his/her secondary education within the district for a continuous period of five (05) years

Note -

1. Candidates selected from the written examination are bound to produce the following documents, as required, during the interview or upon inquiry to prove that they belong to the above district.

I. Birth certificate

II. Grama Niladhari Certificate and Electoral Registers confirming three (03) years of continuous residency.

III. School leaving certificate.

2. In case where a candidate’s father or mother is employed in a transferable service within the Public Service, Provincial Public Service or a State Corporation, the candidate is permitted to choose the birthplace of either parent as the district to which he/ she belongs. (In such cases, the candidate must produce relevant documents at the interview or upon inquiry to prove the parents' birthplace and their employment

status in the Public/Provincial service or State Corporation)

3. No candidate is permitted to compete for vacancies in more than one district. Once a district has been selected in the online application to compete for vacancies in accordance with the qualifications mentioned in paragraph 07(b), it cannot be changed subsequently.

08. Scheme of Examination :

- (a) The examination shall be held in the language media of Sinhala, Tamil and English. Candidates must select a single medium of their choice and must answer all prescribed question papers in the said medium. Candidates shall not be permitted to change the language medium subsequently. The examination shall consist of two question papers.

(01) Aptitude Test:

A question paper consisting of 50 multiple-choice questions shall be provided, to be answered within duration of 01 hour. Out of a total of 100 marks for the paper, a minimum of 40 marks or above must be obtained to pass.

(02) *General Question Paper:*

A question paper of 01 hour duration, consisting of multiple-choice and short answer questions, will be provided to test the General Knowledge, knowledge on Road Rules, Road Signs and Motor Mechanism. Out of a total of 100 marks for the paper, a minimum of 40 marks or above must be obtained to pass.

Note: These question papers are designed to evaluate the qualifications and capability of the candidates in relation to the performance of their duties.

Examination Results: The Department of Examinations, Sri Lanka, will take steps to send a results sheet indicating the marks secured at the written examination for each subject/ total marks

to all candidates, who sat for the examination, by post or issue the results through the website www.results.exams.gov.lk.

09. Interview :

Candidates must secure 40 marks or above for each of the two question papers mentioned above to pass the written examination. Accordingly, candidates who secure the highest marks in the written examination will qualify for the Trade Test and the General Interview based on the number of existing vacancies and the district population ratio.

- i. Candidates will be called for the interview strictly based on the order of merit, prepared in accordance with the total marks secured for both subjects, provided they have exceeded the minimum pass mark for each. This selection will be made in relation to the number of vacancies allocated for each district as specified in paragraph 07 of the notification.

ii. The interview consists of two parts;

- (1) General Interview - This is conducted to verify whether the candidates have satisfied the qualifications as specified in Sections 06 and 07 of the notification for the purpose of receiving an appointment.

- (2) Trade Test – A total of 20 marks shall be allocated for the trade test, and a minimum of 10 marks or above must be obtained to pass. By this test, driving proficiency shall be examined, including the practical application of knowledge on road rules and basic knowledge of motor mechanism.

- iii. Only candidates who pass both the General Interview and the Trade Test will be selected for appointment.

- iv. The marks secured in the Trade Test will not be added to the marks of the written examination.

10. Selection for an appointment :

Candidates will be called for the General Interview and Trade Test on the order of merit based on their marks secured at the written examination in accordance with

the number of vacancies allocated for each district as per paragraph 07 of the notification and those who successfully pass these tests will be selected for appointment to Grade III of the Combined Drivers' Service.

11. Punishment for furnishing false information :

- i. Utmost care should be taken provide accurate information when perfecting the application. If a candidate is found to be ineligible to sit for this examination in accordance with the regulations relevant to the same, his/her candidature is liable to be cancelled at any stage before, during or after the examination.
- ii. If any information furnished by a candidate is subsequently found to be incorrect or if it is revealed that any fact has been willfully suppressed, the candidate will no longer be considered for appointment. Further, he/ she shall be liable to the cancellation of any appointment already granted on account of this examination or even to dismissal from the government service.

12. Conditions of the Examinations :

- (i) Online applications must be perfected in the **English language**. The common instruction sheet prepared for applying for the examination should be downloaded and read before perfecting the online application. These instructions should be strictly followed when perfecting the application. Incomplete applications will be rejected without notice. A notification will be sent *via* SMS to the mobile phone number used to access the system or to the e-mail address, informing the applicant whether the Department of Examinations, Sri Lanka accepts/does not accept the softcopy submitted online by the applicant as a valid application.
- (ii) The examination fee is Rs. 600/-. Payment of examination fee must be made only by the following methods, provided by the online system.
 - i. Any Bank Credit Card,
 - ii. Any Bank Debit Card,
 - iii. Bank of Ceylon Online Banking Method,
 - iv. Bank of Ceylon Teller Slip Payment.

Note: Instructions on the method of payment under the above methods have been given under the technical instructions for the examination on the website.

- (iii) The applicant will be notified of the receipt of payment *via* SMS or e-mail. The full amount for the examination fee must be paid and applications with under payments or over payments of the examination fee will be rejected. The Department of Examinations, Sri Lanka shall not be held liable for any errors occurring when paying examination fees *via* the afore mentioned payment methods.
- (iv) The examination fee shall not be refunded or transferred for another examination under any circumstance.
- (v) The applicants must bear any adverse consequences resulting from delaying the submission of applications until the closing date.
- (vi) On the supposition that only the candidates, who have possessed the qualifications mentioned in the *Gazette* have submitted applications, the Commissioner General of Examinations shall issue admission cards strictly online to the applicants, who have paid the examination fee on or before the closing date of examination and submitted perfected applications online.
- (vii) A notification will be published on the website of the Department of Examinations, Sri Lanka as soon as the admission cards are issued to the applicants and the applicants will be notified *via* SMS. If the admission card is not received steps should be taken to notify the Institutional Examinations Organization Branch of the Department of Examinations in the manner specified in the web notice. It would be advisable to send a letter of request indicating the name of the examination, full name of the applicant, national identity card number and address to the email address mentioned in the web notice. It would be advisable to keep the photocopy of the perfected application and the receipt of payment of examination fee to prove any information inquired by the Department of Examinations.
- (viii) The admission card should be carefully examined and if any revisions are required, the Department of Examinations, Sri Lanka must be contacted to make the necessary revisions in accordance with the application. Requests for revisions made at the examination hall or during the interview will not be considered.

(ix) The signature of the applicant in the admission card for the examination shall have been attested. An applicant applying from a government institution must have his/ her signature attested by the Head of the Institution or an officer authorized by him, while other applicants must have their signature attested by a Principal of a Government School/retired officer, Grama Niladhari of the Division, Justice of Peace, a Commissioner for Oaths, Attorney-at-Law, Notary Public, Commissioned Officer of the three Armed Forces, permanent Officer in Staff Grade of the Public or Provincial Public Service or a Chief Incumbent or Head Priest of a Buddhist temple or clergy of any other religion who holds a considerable position.

- (a) The National Identity Card;
- (b) Valid Passport;
- (c) Valid Sri Lankan Driving License.

Candidates should enter the examination hall without covering their face and ears so that their identity and the fact that they are not wearing any electronic communication devices can be verified. Further, any candidate who refuses to assist for proving his/ her identity shall not be allowed to enter the examination hall. The candidates should remain in the examination hall from the time of entering up to leaving the examination hall without covering face and ears enabling the invigilators to identify the candidate.

(x) All candidates are bound by the rules and regulations imposed by the Commissioner General of Examination in respect of conducting the examination. The candidates shall be subjected to a punishment imposed by the Commissioner General of Examinations, if such rules are violated by them. The decision of the Commissioner General of Examinations with regard to the results of the examination shall be final.

15. The decision of the Director General of Combined Services shall be final in respect of any matter not provided for in this notification.

16. In the event of any inconsistency between the Sinhala, Tamil and English texts of this gazette notification, the Sinhala text shall prevail.
